We will also continue the purposeful and ethical integration of artificial intelligence and educational technologies as tools to enrich learning, creativity, and human potential, building upon the approach established in previous years.



- Finally, we will strengthen **leadership and professional ownership**. Sustainable improvement belongs to everyone. Our leaders and teachers will increasingly work together to examine evidence, share effective practice, test new approaches, and take collective responsibility for improving learning.

And to **our students**: be curious, think deeply, learn from mistakes, use feedback, challenge yourselves, and take pride in your progress.
