The Emirates Standardized Test (EmSAT) Definition

The EmSAT is a national system of standardized computer-based tests, based on United Arab Emirates national standards.



To ensure that students are equipped with the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively participate in the modern knowledge based global society.

1• Assess the knowledge and skills of candidates in the transitional stages after the general education stage and the transition to the higher education stage. **2.** Used for university admission purposes **3.** Used for evaluating the effectiveness of schools' performance and the quality of the educational system and taking the necessary decisions for improvements **4.** Provide decision-makers information about the skills acquired by students in their different academic levels.

5. Assembling accurate data about the knowledge and skills of students in the United Arab Emirates in academic subjects and across different academic cycles in accordance with national standards.

6• Helping students determine the appropriate educational paths

7• Determining the level of students' performance nationally and internationally.

1• Make sure you completed your registration for all the required tests.

2• Make sure you print out all tests tickets and read all the instructions written on it. You also need to make sure of the location of your test center, the date and time of the test.

3• If you are special needs candidate, you need to revise your EmSAT coordinator in your school to register you under Special needs category and attach your medical approved documents.

5. Review the sample item types of each test that you are required to take.

6• It is obligatory for all non-vaccinated candidates to provide the Test Center with a negative (PCR) COVID-19 test result for a time frame no later than 96 hours on Alhosn mobile app and 14 days for vaccinated candidates. And If there was any positive test the candidate should provide two negative test results before registering for the test. 2• Make sure you arrive the test center at least 15 minutes before the test.

3• Make sure you answer ALL the test questions.

4• If you face any technical issues during the test, please inform the invigilator (person in charge) immediately.

• Make sure you send your test session properly by clicking «I am Done» before you leave the test hall otherwise your test score will not be counted.

 It is forbidden to enter your mobile phone, Smart watch, Bluetooth devices, and headphones to the test lab otherwise legal actions will be taken.

After the Test

1 Your results will be posted on your portal, usually within 15 days for grade 12 students and 10 days for other candidates.

2• The only way to get your result is through your EmSAT portal, no results will be released through other channels.
